Ice Breaker

- **Question:** Share a time when you experienced God's goodness in a difficult situation. How did it impact your faith?

Short Summary of the Sermon

The sermon focused on the parable of the rich man and Lazarus from Luke 16:19-31. It highlighted three key lessons about heaven and hell:

1. What matters in this world and what matters in the next life are radically different.
2. One of the greatest torments in hell is realizing how wrong you were in life.
3. We choose what we believe, and our choices have eternal consequences.

The sermon emphasized that our eternal destiny is not determined by our wealth or status but by whether we have surrendered our lives to Jesus Christ. It also underscored the importance of recognizing the futility of worldly pursuits and the eternal significance of our relationship with Jesus.

Group Questions

1. Reflection on the Parable:

3. **Personal Belief:**

- The sermon mentioned that we choose what we believe. What are some beliefs you hold that you think might be influenced by personal desires rather than truth?
- How can we ensure that our beliefs align with the teachings of Jesus?

4. **Impact of Wealth:**

- How can wealth and comfort lull us into spiritual apathy, as it did with the rich man in the parable?
- What steps can we take to guard against this in our own lives?

5. **Eternal Consequences:**

- The sermon highlighted that our eternal location is permanent. How does this truth influence your sense of urgency in sharing the gospel with others?
- What are some practical ways you can share the message of Jesus with those around you?

Life Application

- **Daily Dependence on God:** Reflect on areas in your life where you might be relying more on material wealth or comfort than on God. Make a conscious effort to depend on God daily, seeking His guidance and provision in all things.
- **Eternal Perspective:** Regularly remind yourself of the eternal significance of your actions and decisions. Consider how your choices today will impact your eternity and the eternity of those around you.

Challenge

- **Surrender and Share:** This week, take a step to fully surrender an area of your life to Jesus that you have been holding back. Additionally, share the message of Jesus with at least one person, emphasizing the eternal hope and salvation He offers.
