

# Day 1: Understanding Spiritual Arrogance

**Scripture:** Luke 18:9-14

**Reflection:** Reflect on the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. **Scripture:** Romans 3:23

**Prayer:** Father, I acknowledge my sinfulness and my need for Your grace. Thank You for justifying me through Jesus. Help me to remain humble and dependent on You. Amen.

# Day 3: Cultivating Gratitude

**Scripture:** Colossians 3:16

**Reflection:** Gratitude is a powerful antidote to spiritual arrogance. Consider the blessings in your life and how they are gifts from God. How can you cultivate a heart of gratitude in your daily life?

**Prayer:** Gracious God, thank You for the countless blessings You have given me. Help me to live with a heart full of gratitude, recognizing that all I have is from You. Amen.

# Day 4: Embracing True Humility

**Scripture:** Philippians 2:3-4

**Reflection:** True humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less. It involves valuing others above yourself. How can you practice humility in your interactions with others today?

**Prayer:** Jesus, teach me to be humble as You are humble. Help me to see others through Your eyes and to serve them with love and compassion. Amen.

## Day 5: Living Out Our Faith

**Scripture:** James 4:6
