

# Day 1: Seeing Beyond Physical Sight

**Scripture:** John 9:1-3

**Reflection:** Jesus' disciples asked who sinned to cause the man's blindness, but Jesus redirected their focus to God's work being displayed. Consider how often we focus on blame rather than seeing God's purpose in our circumstances.

**Prayer:** Lord, help me to see beyond the surface and understand Your purpose in my life. Open my eyes to Your work around me.

# Day 2: Jesus' Love for the Unlovely

**Scripture:** Luke 4:18-19

**Reflection:** Jesus spent time with those society often overlooked. Reflect on how Jesus' love for the marginalized challenges us to love those who are different from us.

**Prayer:** Jesus, give me a heart like Yours, one that loves the unlovely and seeks out the marginalized. Help me to be inclusive in my love and actions.

# Day 3: Living Out the Gospel

**Scripture:** James 1:22

**Reflection:** The sermon emphasized living out John 9, not just acting it out. Consider how you can actively live out the Gospel in your daily life.

**Prayer:** Father, empower me to be a doer of Your Word. Let my life reflect the truth of the Gospel in all I do.

# Day 4: Recognizing Spiritual Blindness

**Scripture:** Matthew 15:14

**Reflection:** The sermon highlighted the spiritual blindness of the disciples, townspeople, and Pharisees. Reflect on areas in your life where you might be spiritually blind.

**Prayer:** Lord, reveal any areas of spiritual blindness in my life. Open my eyes to see Your truth and lead me in Your ways.

# Day 5: Grace Greater Than Our Sin

**Scripture:** Ephesians 2:8-9

**Reflection:** Harley's song about grace reminds us of the unmerited favor we receive through Christ. Reflect on the grace that covers all our sins and how it transforms us.

**Prayer:** Thank You, God, for Your amazing grace. Help me to live in the freedom and joy that Your grace provides, sharing it with others.
