

# Day 1: Prioritizing God Above All

**Scripture:** Exodus 20:3 - "You shall have no other gods before me."

**Reflection:** Begin by examining your priorities. What do you value most in your life? Reflect on how you can make God your number one priority. Consider the ways in which you might be placing other "gods" before Him, such as career, relationships, or material possessions.

**Prayer:** Ask God to reveal any idols in your life and to help you place Him at the center of everything you do. Pray for the strength to prioritize Him above all else.

# Day 2: The God of Pleasure

**Scripture:** Ecclesiastes 2:1-2 - "I said to myself, 'Come now, I will test you with pleasure to find out what is good.' But that also proved to be meaningless."

**Reflection:** Reflect on the pursuit of pleasure and how it can become an idol. Consider how Solomon's pursuit of pleasure led to emptiness. What pleasures are you chasing that might be distracting you from God?

**Prayer:** Pray for discernment to recognize when the pursuit of pleasure is leading you away from God. Ask for the Holy Spirit's guidance to find joy and satisfaction in Him alone.

# Day 3: The God of Productivity

**Scripture:** Psalm 127:1 - "Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain."

**Reflection:** Consider how the pursuit of productivity and success can become a god in your life. Reflect on the importance of aligning your work and efforts with God's will. Are you working for His glory or for your own?

**Prayer:** Ask God to help you find balance in your work and to remind you that true success comes from Him. Pray for the ability to work diligently while keeping your focus on His purposes.

# Day 4: The God of Provision

**Scripture:** Matthew 6:19-21 - "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures

in heaven."

**Reflection:** Reflect on how material possessions and the pursuit of wealth can become idols. Consider how you can store up treasures in heaven rather than on earth. What changes can you make to ensure that your heart is set on eternal things?

**Prayer:** Pray for contentment and a heart that values eternal treasures over earthly ones. Ask God to help you use your resources for His kingdom and to trust in His provision.

## Day 5: The God of Popularity

**Scripture:** Galatians 1:10 - "Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people?"

**Reflection:** Reflect on the desire for approval and popularity. Consider how seeking the approval of others can become an idol. Are you more concerned with what people think of you than what God thinks?

**Prayer:** Ask God to help you seek His approval above all else. Pray for the courage to stand firm in your faith, even when it means going against the crowd. Ask for a heart that desires to please Him above all.
